

Alcohol Policy

It is an offence to serve alcohol to a person who is intoxicated. Our staff will refuse service of alcohol, gambling will not be permitted and they will be required to leave the premises and or golf course.

Permitted Locations for Alcohol Use

Alcohol can only be consumed in licensed locations around the property with the exemption of the following:

- Public car park
- Public Roads including open beverages whilst crossing the road from the 11th - 12th and 17th - 18th
- Health Club
- On the golf course if alcohol not purchased from Country Club Tasmania
 - o *A person is not permitted to supply their own alcohol on the course*
 - o *Alcohol not purchased from Country Club Tasmania will be confiscated*
 - o *We reserve the right to search bags*
 - o *Any person who does not comply with the above will be required to leave and fees will be forfeited*

Underage Customers

- It is an offence for a person under the age of 18 years to purchase liquor.
- It is an offence to use a false ID.
- Acceptable forms of ID to prove you are 18 years of age or over include current:
 - o *Driver licence*
 - o *Personal information card*
 - o *Keypass*
 - o *Passport*
 - o *Firearm licence*
 - o *Or government department document*
(*Federal, State or Territory that has holder's name, photograph and age*)
- Any person who sells or supplies liquor to a person under the age of 18 years is guilty of an offence.

Managing the Intoxicated

- In the event that a person appears to be intoxicated or is acting inappropriately, staff will be discreet and politely deal with that person and if necessary seek assistance from security or police.

On Course Etiquette

- Dress regulations must be adhered to at all times which includes clean neat and appropriate dress required at all times with a preference for collared shirt.
- No more than 4 players per group.
- One set of clubs per player.
- Please replace divots.
- Rake bunkers after use.
- Repair pitch marks on greens.
- Play holes in correct sequence.
- If clear hole in front allow faster groups to pass.
- For the safety of all, please ensure the group in front is clearly out of range before you play.
- Don't run. Don't shout. Play quickly, safely and courteously so all can enjoy their game.
- Greenkeepers have the right of way at all times.
